Approval of Minutes: Motion by Bill Dunn to approve the minutes from December 12th meeting. Seconded by Jim Polczynski and carried unanimously.

Old Business:

01 98 03 New Berlin West High School (18695 W. Cleveland Ave.) The City Engineering Department will draw up the area with some recommendations for the County DPW and the School District. Such things as lowering the speed limit to 30mph while the yellow lights are flashing. Fixing the flashing lights, so they only flash when busses are loading before and after school. Moving the 45mph sign that is in front of the school west of the west flashing light. Making the east and west entrances/exits wider. Hold on the agenda.

03 01 10 Sunny Slope and Beloit Rd. Request for traffic signals. A letter has been sent to Robert Haines of the Waukesha County DPW requesting the traffic signals be placed in 2002 and if not provide some temporary measures to help improve safety at the intersection. Hold on the agenda until we have a response from the County.

03 01 06 Fence atop retaining wall at Moorland and Howard. **Motion by Jim Polczynski and seconded by Bill Dunn to move to old business. Carried unanimously.** The Engineering Dept. has had contact with the developer and they advised Badger Railing has the plans and will be starting on the railing soon. Hold on agenda.

02 01 12 Sunny Slope Rd. in the 4333 S. Block. Safety of vehicles entering and exiting the School. Request the Engineering Dept. look and marking turn lanes in front of the school. Hold on agenda.

03 01 12 Calhoun and Addison Intersection safety. Don Ullman advised the City's DPW has cut three trees and moved a sign. This has improved the field of view. **Motion by Bill Dunn and seconded by David Schmidt to drop from the agenda.**

04 01 12 Service Rd. Greenfield and 124th St. "No Parking" signs. **Motion by Randy Alf and seconded by Don Ullman for the following "No Parking" signs on the service road. #1) Dead end on far east end of service Rd. "No Parking From December 1st Through April 01st." #2) South side of the service road. "No Parking" signs starting on the west side of the driveway at 12415 W. Greenfield going west for 25 feet. Then "No Parking" signs from 12525 W. Greenfield (Service Rd.) west to Greenfield Ave. #3) North side of the service road. "No Parking" signs starting 30 feet west of the of the east dead of the service road**

and west to Greenfield Ave. Engineering Dept. will provide Council with a diagram of where these signs would be placed. Carried unanimously. Send recommendation to Council. Hold on agenda.

01 01 03 Elm Grove and Greenfield. Request for "No Parking" signs on the east side of Elm Grove Rd. from Greenfield to Meadow La. Council has approved the signs and the City's DPW will put them up. Hold until the signs have been put up.
