NEW BERLIN SAFETY COMMISSION MINUTES

Wednesday, February 13th, 2002 7:30 p.m.

Approval of Minutes: Motion by Bill Dunn to approve the minutes from January 09th, 2002 meeting. Seconded by Jim Polczynski and carried unanimously.

Old Business:

01 98 03 New Berlin West High School (18695 W. Cleveland Ave.) Several citizens and officials attended and spoke on the matter. Pauline Jaske – County supervisor, Robert Haines – County DPW, Dave Ament – 7th District Alderman, Lorinda Percifeld – Bus Co. and Peg Bentley Citizen of New Berlin. The following are the changes that were suggested by the attendees and the commission and who will tend to the items.

1. Flashing lights(timer) School
2. Widen east and west driveways - School
3. Bus and vehicle traffic patterns – School and Bus Company
4. Acceleration/ Deceleration lane on south side of Cleveland Ave between east and west driveways and extended – County DPW. (Spring 2002)
5. 25mph signs "When Children are Present" signs. – County DPW.
6. Commitment to enforcement – New Berlin Police Dept.
7. Lt. Alf will send County Supervisor Pauline Jaske a copy of the Commissions letter of request sent to Mr. Bolte March 28th of 2000 to lower Cleveland Ave speed limit to 35mph between 17400 and Wher Rd. (02 00 01)

Commission will hold on it's agenda until changes are made.

03 01 10 Sunny Slope and Beloit Rd. Request for traffic signals. A letter was received from Richard Bolte of the Waukesha County DPW advising they have made some changes to the intersection, but they have not moved up the installation date of the traffic signals. There has been a 20% increase in traffic from 2000 to 2001 and the County DPW will keep monitoring the area. The accident data for 2001 and the percentage increase of traffic would indicate the signal be moved up, but the County wants to gather more data in 2002/2003 before they move it up. Mr. Haines from the County DPW advised they're looking at about 2005 for the installation of the traffic signals. He did say that in the past the County and City of New Berlin have made arrangements to have the signals installed at the Cities expense and the County would reimburse

the City in the year the intersection was scheduled for installation from their list.

The commission does not feel there is anymore we can do at this point. ***Motion to drop by Steve Bartelt and seconded by Bill Dunn. Motion carried unanimously.*** Lt. Alf to contact interested parties.

03 01 06 Fence atop retaining wall at Moorland and Howard. Ron Schildt reports the contractor said they would have the fence up by 02-15-02. Hold on agenda.

02 01 12 Sunny Slope Rd. in the 4333 S. Block. Safety of vehicles entering and exiting the School. Request the Engineering Dept. look and marking turn lanes in front of the school. This area does not seem to be in need of change at this time. ***Motion to drop from the agenda by Bill Dunn and seconded by Jim Polczynski. Motion carried unanimously.***

04 01 12 Service Rd. Greenfield and 124th St. "No Parking" signs. Council passed a resolution to place the "No Parking " signs. Hold on agenda until signs are up.

01 01 03 Elm Grove and Greenfield. Request for "No Parking" signs on the east side of Elm Grove Rd. from Greenfield to Meadow La. ***Motion to Drop By Randy Alf and seconded by Steve Bartelt as the signs are posted. Carried unanimously.***
