Approval of Minutes: Motion by Don Ullman to approve the minutes from the August 14th, meeting. Seconded by Ron Schildt and carried. Chiovatero, Bartelt, Goedheer and Dunn voting present.

Old Business:

01 98 03 New Berlin West High School (18695 W. Cleveland Ave.)

The School District is working on widening the driveways. Hold on the agenda.

01 02 05 Moorland Rd. North of I43. Request for a "No U Turn" sign for those vehicles that turn north and then make a "U" turn and head southbound. Waiting for county's work and further study. Hold on the agenda.

01 02 06 School Zones in the City. The Highway Department will be placing, in the appropriate locations, "School Ahead" and "Speed Limit" sign per statutory regulations. Motion by Ron Schildt to send to Council the recommendation that School Speed Limits for City jurisdiction be set by ordinance at 10 mph under the posted limit for the roadway that the school is located on. This would give consistency to the posted mph in school zones. Seconded by Bill Dunn. Motion carried unanimously. Hold on the agenda.

01 01 02 Cold Spring Rd. Between Sunny slope and 124th St. The road is posted. Motion by Alderman Chiovatero to remove from the agenda. Seconded by Randy Alf. Motion carried unanimously. Drop from agenda.

01 02 08 Alleyways of Greenfield Ave. Officers have been monitoring the area and people have seemed to have slowed down. Commission feels this is not an item that needs further action by its body. The Police Department will continue to monitor and enforce as need be. Motion by Bill Dunn to drop from agenda. Seconded by Jack Chiovatero. Motion carried unanimously. Drop from the agenda.

02 02 08 Eastbound Greenfield Ave. at Sunny Slope Rd. Request to change the stop sign to a yield sign. In speaking to the State Highway Supervisors there was a flaw in the intersection design and there is no lane for vehicles to go into when they leave Greenfield Ave. on to Sunny Slope Rd. Therefore there must be stop signs and not yield signs. Motion by Randy Alf to drop from our agenda. Seconded by Bill Dunn. Motion carried unanimously. Drop from the agenda.

Tabled Items:

03 00 06 Keep Kids Alive (Tabled 10/11/00) No action. Motion to move to Old Business by Bill Dunn and seconded by Jack Chiovero. Carried unanimously. Motion to drop from the agenda with the notation that the Safety Commission receives and annual update on the program. Motion carried unanimously. Drop from the agenda.

New Business:

01 02 09 Weatherstone Blvd and Victoria Cir. Request for 4-way stop signs. Commission to study. Hold on the agenda.

02 02 09 Bicycle Path Safety. Commission to look at closer. Hold on the agenda.

03 02 09 158th St. at St Francis. Request for stop or yield signs. Possible sight distance problems due to bushes at the intersection and also the speed of the cars using 158th St as a cut through. Commission to study further. Hold on the agenda.

04 02 09 El Dorado and Monterey. Would like to stop signs on Monterey. Vehicles speed through intersection and there are trees and bushes that obstruct the sight distances. Commission to Study. Hold on the agenda. Several area citizens attended the meeting with their concerns.

05 02 09 Regal Dr. by Regal Park. Request to place no parking signs on one side of the street, because what a soccer game is being played cars park on both side of Regal and then there is only one lane of travel. Commission to study. Hold on the agenda.

Motion by Bill Dunn to adjourn the meeting at 8:30 p.m. Seconded by David Schmidt and carried unanimously.
