01 00 12 Emmer Dr. & Stratton Dr. – Unsafe Intersection, Eastbound and Westbound (Council made motion on 11/28/00 to place a temporary "Yield" sign at this intersection; referred to Safety Commission to study.) After further study and discussion, the Commission feels that the "Yield" signs are not adequate or consistent with other industrial park intersections in the City. **Motion by Don Ullman to recommend to Council to replace the temporary yield signs with stop signs; place stop signs for east and westbound traffic on Stratton Dr. at Emmer Dr. Seconded by Steve Bartelt and carried unanimously.** This item should remain on the agenda pending Council action.
