### OPEN SESSION

#### **Possible Action on Hiring, Procedures and Minimum Qualifications, Any Necessary Modifications to Commission Rules**

Motion by Commissioner Pedersen to amend Commission Rule 5.02 as follows: Each original entrance review shall consist of the following and shall be administered as follows: A) Physical performance and written examination shall be conducted in any sequence; B) Following completion of Section A above, oral interview and assessment center shall be conducted in any sequence; C) Following completion of Section A & B above, the Character Investigation, Psychological Testing and Medical Examination shall be conducted in any sequence.

In addition, Commission Rule 5.025 is amendment as follows: Each original entrance review for position of Cadet shall consist of the following and be administered as follows: A) Physical Performance and Written Examination shall be conducted in any sequence; B) Following completion of Section A above, Oral Interview and Character Investigation shall be conducted in any sequence; C) Following Completion of Section A & B above, the Psychological Testing and Medical Examination shall be conducted in any sequence. Seconded by Commissioner Pedersen and carried unanimously.

Motion by Commissioner Lorbiecki to amend number sequence as follows: Commission Rule 12.01 to be 11.01 and 11.01 to be 12.01. Seconded by Commissioner Pedersen and carried unanimously.

Motion by Commissioner Andries to modify all subsequent numbers and Commission Rule 5.06 to read as follows: 5.06 - The Assessment Center shall be a series of testing scenarios designed to evaluate the response of the applicant in various job-like situations. Seconded by Commissioner Pedersen and carried unanimously.

Motion by Commissioner Pedersen to adjourn the meeting at 7:10 P.M. Second by Commissioner Jordan and carried unanimously.
