

## NEW BERLIN SAFETY COMMISSION MINUTES

Wednesday August 9<sup>th</sup> , 2006 6:30pm

### Old Business:

01 06 02 Beloit Rd and Calhoun Rd. Due to the reconstruction, this intersection has become much larger. There is concern that with the widening of the intersection the stop signs are so far off to the right that they are being lost, making for an unsafe situation. (Similar to the situation we have at Beloit and Sunny Slope.) A letter was sent to the county DPW Director Rich Bolte to see if they would make some improvements so the signs stand out more. We will hold this item on the agenda for Director Bolte's reply. No Action taken.

02 06 02 Bicyclist on sidewalks – Ron Schildt will add some detail to the possible ordinance to allow bicycles on sidewalks where there are no bike paths. Hold on the agenda.

01 06 05 Egofske and Martha. Request for streetlight and other possible actions to improve safety in this area. It is not common for the City to place streetlights within a subdivision. It does not appear that one is need at this location. The commission does not recommend a streetlight at this location. Motion to drop by Paul Rozek and seconded by Fred Witty. Motion carried. Drop from the agenda.

01 06 06 Request for safety measures, such as speed tables, to slow traffic on Barton Rd. After further study was done by the commission and the commission does not recommend speed tables at this time. The commission will table this item for now and do a new speed study in October, which is six months after the speed limit was changed to 30 mph. The commission will revisit this item after we have the speed

survey. Motion by Ron Schildt and seconded by Fred Witty. Motion carried. Move to tabled items.
