02 03 08 Parking concerns in front of Glen Park School due to the number of people coming to watch little league baseball. Commission to study. Hold on the agenda.

- *01 05 06 Grange Ave from 124th Street to Moorland Rd. Request to lower speed limit from 35mph to 30 mph and a request to make that stretch of roadway a no passing zone in both directions. There were several citizens present to speak on this issue. A petition was presented lowering the speed limit to 30 mph and making grange a no passing zone. The citizens would request these changes be done on Grange from 124th St. to Moorland Rd. Some of the reasons cited for the changes are: increased traffic, safety of citizens using the road caused by the speed of cars and the very narrow to non-existent shoulders. Besides the increased safety for the neighborhood it would also make this section of Grange Ave consistent with Grange Ave to the east of 124th St. The commission will hold on it's agenda and study further.
