SAFETY COMMISSION MINUTES

Communications: Request for action statement 02 03 08.

Approval of Minutes: Motion by Bill Dunn accepts the January minutes as read. Seconded by Jim Moczydlowski and motion carried.

Old Business:

02 03 08 No Parking on Glen Park by the school. Jack Chiovatero took the commission recommendation to council to allow parking on the east side of Glen Park, from Butternut Tr. to Redwood Tr. (Note: Some no parking signs just south of Butternut Tr. will have to be removed.) **Motion** by Randy Alf and seconded by Lynn Dahlvik to drop from the agenda as the request was approved by council and the signs are posted. Motion carried. Drop from the agenda.

01 03 11 Highpointe and National. Cars for sale parked on Highpointe south of National Ave. The City already has an ordinance that that has to do with line of sight at intersections and that there is to be no parking within 75 feet of a stop sign. The "No Parking Here to Corner" sign is now posted. **Motion** by Bill Dun and seconded by Ron Schildt to drop from the agenda as the sign is posted. Motion carried. Drop from the agenda.

Tabled Items:

01 03 09 Poplar Creek School. By-pass lane/right turn lane for eastbound traffic on Cleveland in front of the school. Tony Goedheer reports this work is scheduled to be done during the parking lot paving phase after the schools current construction is completed. No action.

New Business:

- 01 04 02 Request for cautionary signs warning of emergency vehicles entering on to National Ave, Casper Dr. and Al Stigler PKWY. **Motion** by Bill Dunn and seconded Lynn Dahlvik to place these signs on Casper north of Al Stigler PKWY for southbound traffic. On Al Stigler PKWY east and west of the Police and Fire driveways for east and westbound traffic. This item should go to the City DPW for placement of the signs. The motion also includes requesting of the cautionary signs on National Ave, east and west of Casper and Al Stigler PKWY for east and westbound traffic. The Safety Commission will send a letter to Waukesha County DPW requesting the signs. Motion carried. Hold on the agenda.
- 02 04 02 Request for “All Way Stop” at Cold Spring and Weatherstone BLVD. Traffic Engineer Ron Schildt advised the research data does not meet the traffic standards criteria to place an all way stop at this location. **Motion** by Lynn Dahlvik and seconded by Jim Moczydlowski to deny and drop from the agenda as it does not meet traffic standards criteria for placing stops signs at this intersection. Motion carried. Drop from agenda.
- 03 04 02 Request for “All Way Stop” at Cold Spring and Sommerset DR./ Wilshire Dr. **Motion** by Lynn Dahlvik and seconded by Jim Moczydlowski to deny the request and drop from the agenda for the same reasons as mentioned above in 02 04 02. Motion carried. Drop from the agenda.

Motion by Bill Dunn and seconded by Ron Schildt to adjourn the meeting at 6:57pm. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned.
