Approval of Minutes: **Motion** by Jim Polczynski to approve the minutes from November 13th, meeting. Seconded by Don Ullman and carried.

Old Business:

- 01 98 03 New Berlin West High School (18695 W. Cleveland Ave.)
The School District is working on widening the driveways. The funds have been budgeted and the work should begin in the spring. Hold on the agenda. **Motion to table this item Jack Chiovatero and seconded by Bill Dunn. Motion carried. Table Item.**
- 01 02 05 Moorland Rd. North of I43. Request for a “No U Turn” sign for those vehicles that turn north and then make a “U” turn and head southbound. **Motion to deny request and drop from the agenda as the intersection reconstruction has been completed and the signs are not necessary. Motion by Bill Dunn and seconded by Jim Polczynski. Motion carried. Drop from the agenda.**
- 01 02 09 Weatherstone Blvd and Victoria Cir. Request for 4-way stop signs. The traffic safety data does not warrant the placing of stop signs at this location. **Motion to drop by Jack Chiovatero and seconded by Don Ullman. Motion carried. Drop from the agenda.**
- 02 02 09 Bicycle Path Safety. The Commission requests the Police Department’s bike patrol give the bike paths extra patrol in the spring, summer and fall. The Safety Commission would like a report as to if there were any safety issues or not. **Motion to table this item by Bill Dunn and seconded by Jim Polczynski. Motion carried. Table this item.**

- 04 02 09 El Dorado and Monterey. Would like to stop signs on Monterey. Traffic safety data gathered electronically, by the City Engineer's Office and NBPB's Officers indicates this intersection does not meet the requirements for the posting of stop signs. Speed surveys, accident data and sight distances indicate this is a very safe intersection as it is. The Commission feels posting of Stop Signs in a location that does not require them would not make an intersection more safe. **Motion to deny the request and drop from the agenda. Motion by Ron Schildt and seconded by Bill Dunn. Motion carried. Drop from the agenda.**
- 05 02 09 Regal Dr. by Regal Park. Request to place no parking signs on one side of the street, because when a soccer game is being played cars park on both sides of Regal and then there is only one lane of travel. **Motion by Jack Chiovaturo to recommend to Council "No Parking" signs to be posted on the west side of Regal Dr. from the north line of the park south to Mayflower Dr. Seconded by Bill Dunn. Motion carried unanimously. Send to Council and hold on the agenda.**
- 01 02 11 Calhoun Rd. 2830 south Block. Vehicles are using the improved shoulder for a traffic lane. The City has posted "No Passing on the Shoulder" signs. **Motion to drop by Jack Chiovaturo and seconded by Bill Dunn. Motion carried. Drop from the agenda.**
- 02 02 11 I 43 Signing of Roadways that go over and under I 43. The City Engineer's Office has sent a letter requesting the Wisconsin DOT review our request. (Items 02 02 11 and 03 02 11)
- 03 02 11 I 43 Safety fences on the overpasses of I 43. (Letter sent)

New Business:

- 01 02 12 Calhoun and Liberty Lane. The lighted business sign of Southwest Metal Finishing makes it difficult to see at night. Commission to study and City Engineer's Office will check with WE Energies to see about placing a streetlight at that intersection. Hold on the agenda.

Motion by Jim Polczynski to adjourn the meeting at 8:08 p.m. Seconded by Bill Dunn and carried unanimously.
