Old Business:

05 02 09 Regal Dr. by Regal Park. The reason the 'No Parking' signs are not up is due to the ground being frozen. The signs will be put up when the ground thaws. Hold on the agenda.

02 02 11 I-43 crossroad signage. Correspondence was sent to Ron Schildt from Thomas Heydel, a Traffic Operations Engineer from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WIDOT). Signs indicating crossroads will be installed at the locations named in the communiqué within the next 6 months. (Letter also addressed item 03 02 11). The ground frost is such that the signs cannot be placed at this time. Once the ground thaws the signs will be erected and this item can be removed from the agenda. Hold on agenda at this time.

03 02 11 I-43 overpass safety fences. A check of Police Department records does not indicate a pattern or problem of items being thrown off the overpasses. The Commission believes the fence over I43 at Sunny Slope should still be installed. There are several subdivisions south of the overpass and many children cross this bridge to go to school and to play with friends in the subdivisions that are just north of the bridge. Ron Schildt will communicate with Mr. Thomas Heydel the Safety Commissions continued concerns for the Sunny Slope overpass. The Commission does not feel the Racine overpass is a concern at this time as there is very little pedestrian traffic on this overpass. This matter will remain on the agenda.
