

## 2017 Wisconsin Act 105

**Enhanced Penalties for State Statutes:** 346.05(1), 346.06, 346.07(2)or(3), 346.09, 346.18, 346.23, 346.31, 346.37(1)(a)1, 1(c)3 or 1(d)1, 346.39(1), 346.46(1)or(4)(a), 346.47(1)or(2) 346.87

**If a person receives and is convicted of violating any of the above state statutes, the Department of Transportation shall order the person to attend a vehicle right-of way course**

**Additionally**, if the violation resulted in bodily harm, great bodily harm or death to another, the person may be subject to an enhanced forfeiture and a suspension of their operating privilege shall be ordered as follows:

- 2-month suspension – 346.18 violations only, resulting in bodily harm to another
- 3-month suspension – For all statutes listed above resulting in great bodily harm to another
- 9-month suspension – For all statutes listed above resulting in death to another

If the vehicle right-of-way course is not completed within six months of the department ordering the person to attend the course, the department shall suspend their operating privilege until successful completion of the course. The department may not suspend a person's operating privilege for more than five years. If the person's operating privilege is suspended, they will not be eligible to reinstate until successful completion of the right-of-way course.

This course has been designed to acquaint individuals with the vehicle right-of-way rules and provide instruction on motorcycle, pedestrian and bicycle awareness.
