In order to bring a sustainable and safe new water supply to Waukesha, **new infrastructure has to be built**, including a booster pumping station and reservoirs.

The selected site is the least disruptive to neighborhoods, and does not require taking down any trees or buildings. **No other alternative meets these criteria.**

The station and reservoir tanks are discreet and quiet. Research shows they will not affect private wells or property value.
