

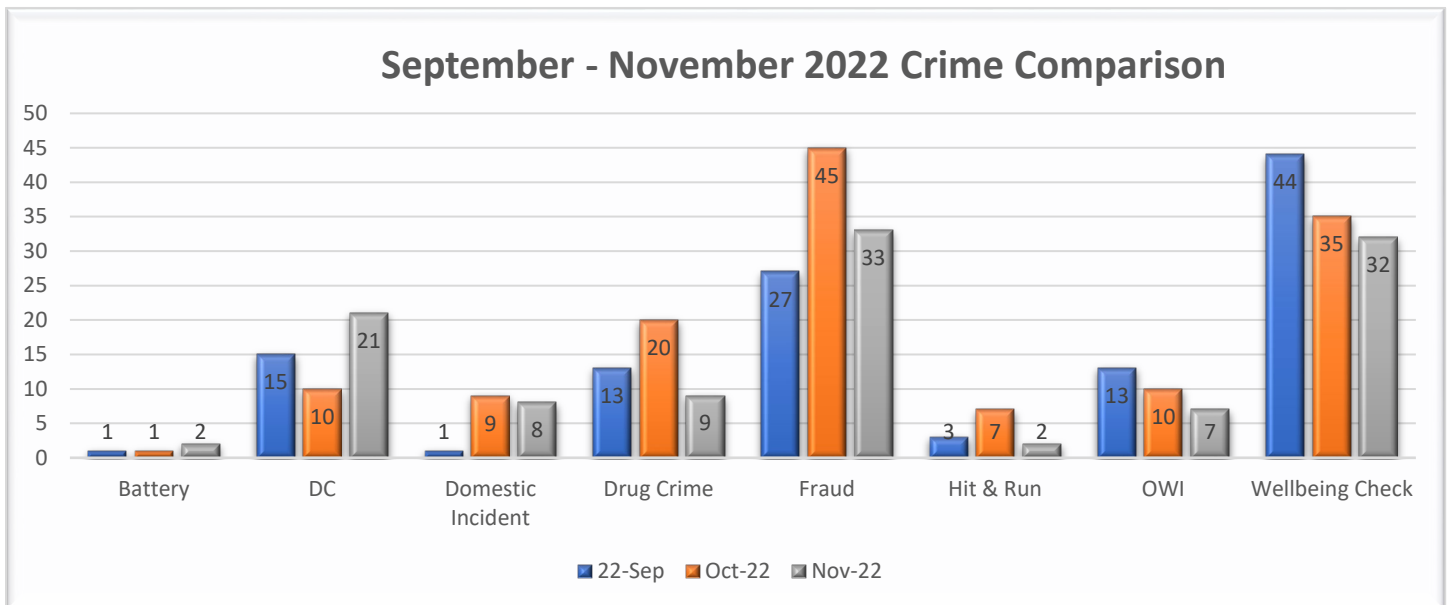

## NBPD Monthly Update – December 2022

**NEW BERLIN POLICE CRIME STATISTICS:** In November 2022, the New Berlin Police Department initiated or responded to 2,346 calls for service. The below graphs represent primary categories during this reporting period in which our patrol division allocated resources. The majority of the OWI's & Drug Crimes are a result of proactive officer activity, usually stemming from a traffic stop. The remainder of the graphed categories in which we become involved, is a result of a victim, witness or a concerned citizen requesting our assistance with that respective incident.

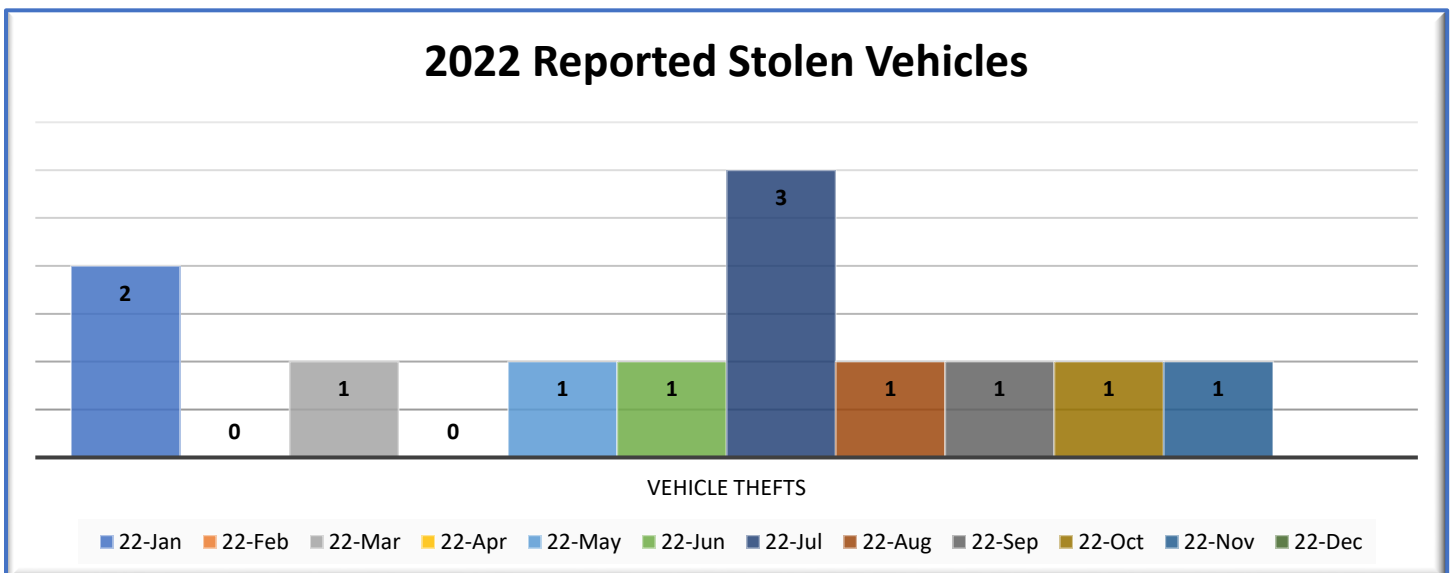
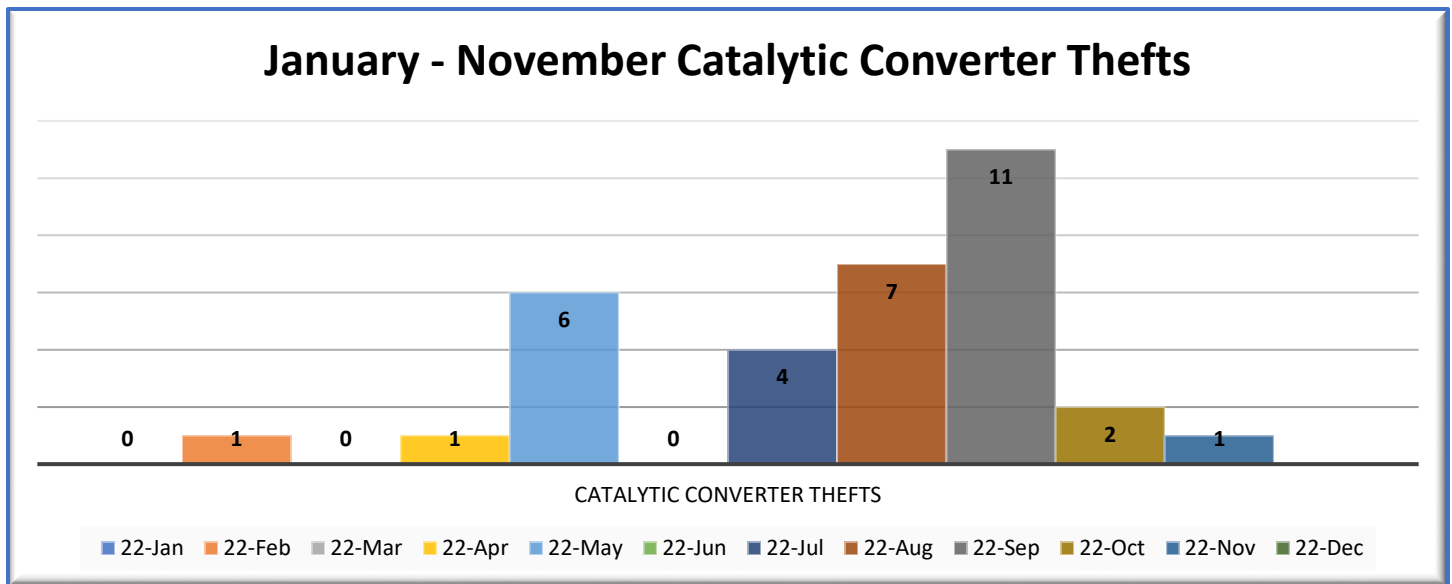
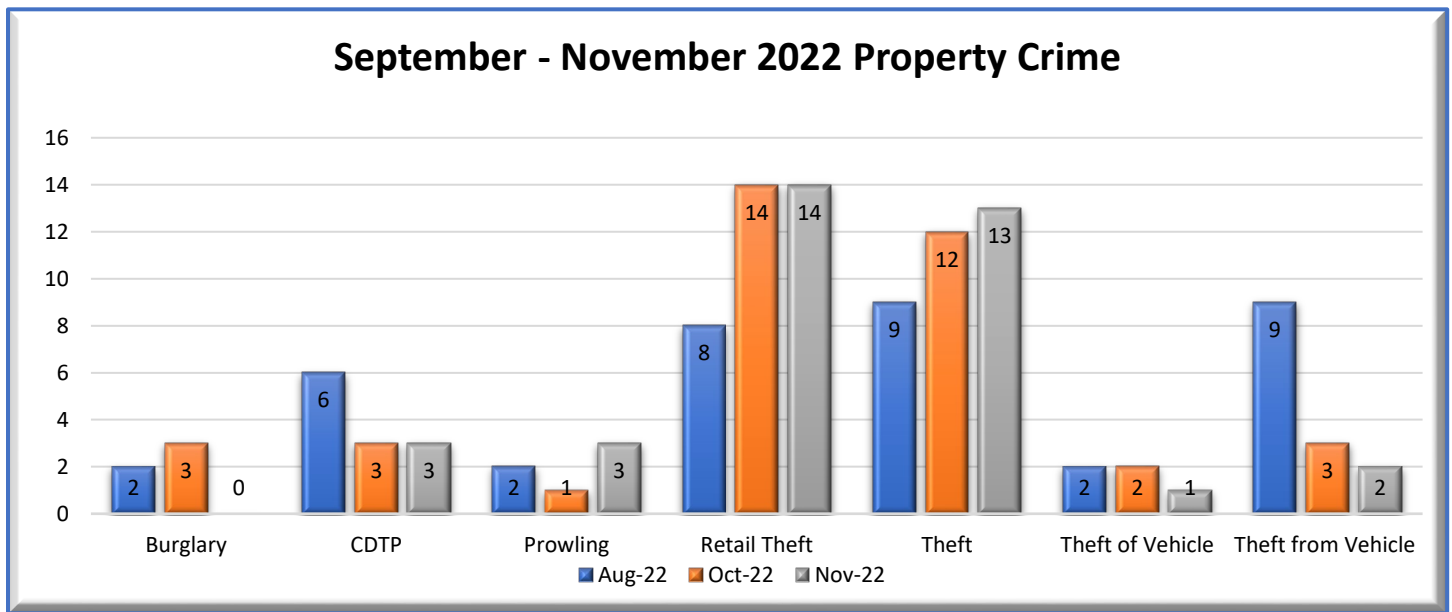

The majority of the wellbeing checks in which we responded involved people experiencing a crisis related to their mental health. **PROPERTY CRIME UPDATE:**

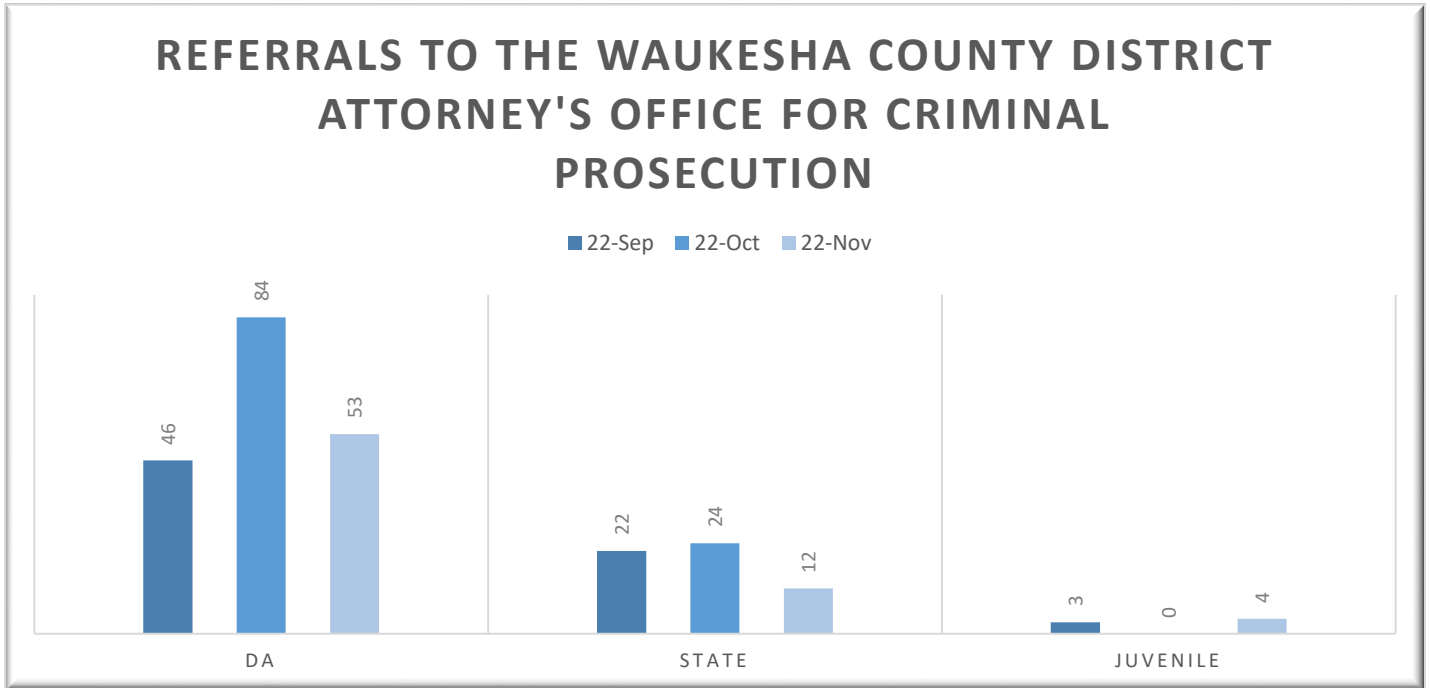




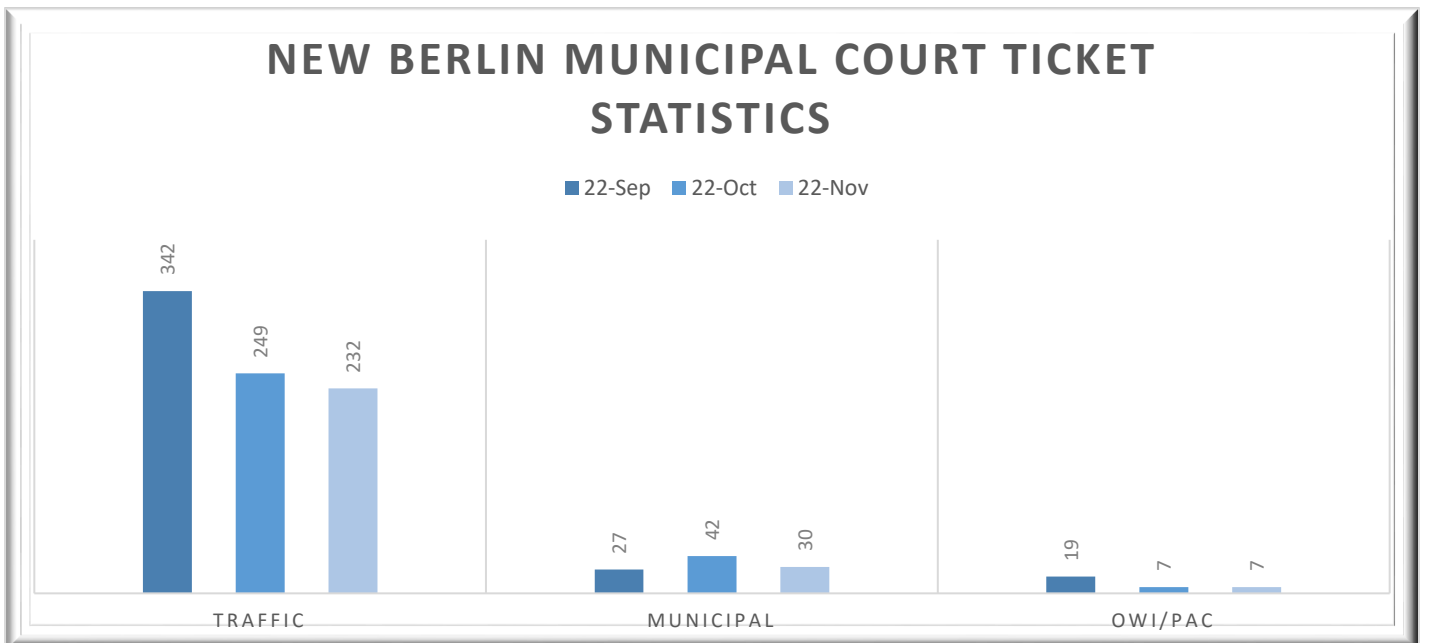
- **BE AWARE:** Pay attention to your surroundings at all times
- **BE READY:** Before you exit a store, have your car keys in your hand
- **BE SMART:** Park in a well-lit area in the line of sight of the stores entrance/exit
- **STOP IT:** Don't look/engage on your phone or smart device while walking or when sitting in your car
- **SECURE IT:** Lock your vehicle when you exit, and as soon as you enter it
- **HIDE IT:** Place valuables and packages in your trunk or other places where they aren't visible. Don't overload yourself with packages.
- **PROTECT IT:** Carry only the charge cards that you will need. Avoid carrying or flashing large amounts of cash.

**CALL 911 IF YOU SEE ANYTHING SUSPICIOUS!**

**REFERRALS FOR CRIMINAL PROSECUTION:** In November of 2022, the New Berlin PD referred 57 charges involving adult & Juvenile offenders to the Waukesha County District Attorney's Office for case review, reference misdemeanor or felony prosecution. Additionally, 12 criminal traffic citations were issued.



**REFERRALS FOR MUNICIPAL PROSECUTION:** In November of 2022, the New Berlin PD issued a total of 269 municipal citations for non-criminal prosecution in New Berlin Municipal Court. 232 citations were traffic related, 30 citations were non-traffic related & 7 citations were OWI/PAC related.

# PUBLIC NOTICE

The New Berlin Police Department is scheduled for an on-site assessment as part of a program to achieve accreditation by verifying that it meets professional standards.

Administered by the Wisconsin Law Enforcement Accreditation Group (WILEAG), the accreditation program requires law enforcement agencies to comply with state-of-the-art standards in four basic areas: policy and procedures, administration, operations, and support services.

Agency employees and the public are invited to offer comments by calling 262-754-1890 on December 14<sup>th</sup>, between the hours of 1:00 pm and 3:00 pm. Comments will be taken by the WILEAG Assessment Team assigned to conduct this assessment.

Telephone comments are limited to ten (10) minutes and must address the New Berlin Police Department's ability to comply with WILEAG's standards. **NEW BERLIN POLICE CRIME STATISTICS PUBLIC DASHBOARD – BULLETIN BOARD FEATURE:** We are pleased to introduce a new feature to our public dashboard, the bulletin board. The bulletin board enables us to post community events, crime alerts and other information impacting our community. Upon accessing the NBPD Crime Statistics Public Dashboard, the "Recent Events" tab is in your viewer by default. To view the "Bulletin Board," click on the "Bulletin Board" tab at the bottom left corner of your screen. The most recent posts appear at the top of your screen. Many of the posts contain picture or PDF document attachment pertaining to the post. By clicking on any specific post, any attachments(s) associated with the post will appear in the right column (over the map) in a dialogue box. Clicking on the attachment in the dialogue box will open the document/picture.
