
Application Requirements

1. A completed and signed [Miscellaneous Permit Form](#) with applicable fees.
2. A **separate detailed drawing**, on a survey or site plan, including the house, location of the generator, measurements of the generator, and distance between the house and generator. If no survey or site plan is available, the applicant can request a site plan from the City.
 - a. See below for example of detailed drawing.
3. A completed [Electrical Permit Application](#) signed by a State of Wisconsin certified electrician with a valid electrical contractor license with applicable fees.
 - a. An automatic standby generators typically to include a service alteration, transfer switch, and the generator.
 - b. Electrician should indicate if generator is to be connected to line or load side of electrical service on Electrical Permit Application.

Guidelines

1. Location.
 - a. A generator must meet all front, side and rear yard setbacks of the zoning district per § 275-42F(2). For questions about front, side, and rear yard setbacks, contact the Planning Department at 262-797-2445.
