### Public Notification Meeting Video Recording Access

On 11/13/2024, the New Berlin Police Department, in cooperation with the Wisconsin Department of Corrections, hosted a public notification and informational meeting pertaining to the mandatory release of a convicted child sex offender (Nicholas Weaver) from incarceration. On 11/19/2024, Mr. Weaver, will have completed his court ordered prison sentence and will be returning to his New Berlin residence at 13500 W. Linfield Dr. Mr. Weaver will be under court-ordered active community supervision by the Wisconsin Department of Corrections for the next five years. His supervision will include GPS monitoring, regular meetings with his probation agent, no access to social media, strict limitations on his travel outside his residence, no unsupervised contact with any minors, no contact with victim(s), and other stringent rules as prescribed by the Department of Corrections.

Mr. Weaver's court ordered sentence also required him to register as a sex offender through 11/22/2044 and is ordered to comply with all requirements of the Wisconsin Sex Offender Registry. Additionally, in collaboration with the Sex Offender Registry, the New Berlin Police Department conducts biannual home visits with each sex offender residing in the city and reports any non-compliance issues directly to the Registry Specialist for prosecution.

New Berlin City ordinance 188-17 regulates sex offenders to include residency restrictions. Generally, registered sex offenders convicted of child sex crimes are prohibited from residing within 500 feet of a designated child safety location, such as a park. In accordance with the US Constitution and case law, this ordinance includes an original domicile exception; thus, allowing offenders to return to their residence post incarceration if residency was established prior to the ordinance effective date of 6/28/2017.

Mr. Weaver does qualify under the original domicile exception to reside at 13500 W. Linfield Dr., which is located within 500 feet of Weatherstone Park. Mr. Weaver will NOT be allowed to access this park or any other park in New Berlin. Any attempt to access off-limit locations as determined by Mr. Weaver's probation agent, such as a park or school, will initiate a police response via the electronic monitoring service. It should be noted the City of New Berlin does not have the authority or means to prevent or appeal Mr. Weaver's release from prison or his residency in New Berlin.
