**RESIDENTIAL USE ONLY. A valid photo ID is required for entry.**

To obtain a waiver of use for special circumstances, stop in at the Streets Dept. office at 16550 W. National Ave. with a photo ID showing your current address and proof of property in New Berlin.

ITEMS AVAILABLE TO RESIDENTS

FREE compost and wood chips.

Bring a shovel and pail to load yourself OR have a loader dump wood chips or compost (no dirt) into your trailer.

A Release of Liability loader permit is required for this service and can be obtained at City Hall or at the Streets Dept. office, 16550 W. National Ave.

\*Loaders are available only on Tue. and Thur. from 10am-1:30pm.

(No dual axle trucks—3/4 ton or less)

**\*\*Not for commercial use—Contractors will NOT be allowed into the Recycle Center\*\***

## **ACCEPTED ITEMS**

During Operating Hours ONLY  
—No Illegal Dumping—

**Appliances:** Oven/Range, Fridge/Freezer, Dishwasher, Microwave, Washer/Dryer, Water Heater, A/C, Furnace, Boilers, Dehumidifier, Metal Water Softener.

**Misc:** Grills, Lawn Mower, Snow Blower (fluids drained).

Other Scrap Metals include Motors, Cast Iron, Nuts/Bolts

**Car / Garage:** Car Batteries ONLY, Anti-Freeze -Used (3-Gal max per visit), Motor Oil-Used, and anything oil based: Trans Fluid, Oil Filters, Lamp Oil.

**Yard Waste:** Branches (less than 12” diameter—NO Stumps or Root Balls), Logs up to 6’, Leaves, Grass Clippings, Garden Foliage. Dirt/ Sod: 1 cubic yard max per visit (NO mix of dirt and stone)  
\*Real Christmas trees w/out decor

**Cans/Glass:** Aluminum, Steel, Tin Cans, Bottles/Jars only (NO broken glass or windows). Plastic Bottles coded 1,2,5 ONLY

**Cardboard/Paper:** Flattened and bundled to 4’ x 3’, newspapers, books, junk mail.

\*Invasive species i.e.; garlic mustard should be placed in clear plastic bags and put in your trash.

\*\*Due to concerns with Emerald Ash Borer, no wood products should be transported outside Waukesha County.

## **ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED** **NO Hazardous Waste**

**Household:** Power Tool Batteries, Mattresses, Furniture, Carpeting, Windows, Broken Glass, Mirrors, Toilets, Trash

**Misc:** Styrofoam, Concrete, Cooking Oils

**Garage/Auto:** Wires, Chains, Fluorescent Bulbs, Tires, Gasoline or Oil/Gas mix

Driveway Sealer, Gasoline, Cleaners—  
See hazardous waste disposal.

**Lawn/Outdoor:** Landscape Ties, Colored mulch, Rocks, Bricks, Sand, Stumps, Roots, Concrete, Construction Debris, Lumber/Treated wood, Hoses, Propane Tanks, Landscape Fabric, Straw or Weed Matting.

**ELECTRONICS:** Computers, TVs, or other Electronics.
