Commemorative Tree Program

Trees make a community more attractive and increase the quality of life. They play an important part in shaping our attitude and state of mind. A gift of a tree provides a lasting commemorative and is a wonderful way to beautify New Berlin.

Select a tree from the following list:

Autumn Brilliance Serviceberry (Amelanchier x grandiflora) – #20 container tree **\$230**.

A beautiful smaller stature tree with smooth grey bark. Clusters of hanging white flowers producing edible berries in early summer. Outstanding orange to pink fall color.

Harvest Gold Linden (Tilia x Harvest Gold) – #25 container tree **\$190**.

An upright tree that develops a beautiful exfoliating bark with age. Green heart-shaped leaf turning yellow in fall with fragrant yellow flowers late spring. This variety is resistant to Japanese beetle damage. Mature height 40’.

Eastern Redbud (Cercis canadensis) – #25 container tree **\$215**.

A small stature tree that flowers purple in spring along its branches, and will provide spring interest even in less than ideal light conditions. Green leaves turning yellow in fall. Mature height 20-30’.

Hybrid Swamp x Bur Oak (Quercus x schuettei) – #25 container tree **\$215**.

A hybrid between a bur oak and a swamp white oak. It’s a medium sized conical shade tree that is adaptable to a variety of site conditions. With age it rounds and broadens out. 40-60’ tall. A good choice in parks and as a future shade tree.

Early Glow Buckeye (Aesculus glabra) #25 container tree **\$240**.

Beautiful yellow-green spring flowers, & early bright red fall make the Early Glow Buckeye a great ornamental interest in a park or public setting. It can reach 35 feet tall, by 35 feet wide. This is a good all-around ornamental and shade tree at maturity.

The Department of Public Works will order the tree once payment is received. Commemorative Trees are planted in the fall and maintained by the City. The names of those honored and the names of the donors will be prominently displayed on a “Commemorative Tree Plaque” located in City Hall or the New Berlin Hills Golf Course Clubhouse. There is also an optional brick that can be purchased for **\$50** (engraved with the name of the person honored) to be placed by the Commemorative Tree. Recognition cards will be sent to all donors and the families of those being honored.
